The event will take place at the Orchard Gardens Boys and Girls Club located at 2 Dearborn Street in Roxbury.

The Village in Progress campaign is a response by those invested in the community to continue the commitment to make violence an unacceptable action.

Madison Park Development Corporation's Vice President of Programs, Yun-Ju Choi, praised the campaign saying, "The goal of our Village in Progress campaign is to ignite action in the community and empower our residents to identify solutions to rebuild their village."
